Student's satisfaction survey was important for any institution to achieve the goals of teaching and learning and to fulfill the needs of the students, institution, and its stakeholders. Questionnaire was constructed comprising 21 questions through online mode response were collected for further analysis. The following are Observations of Students satisfaction survey 2021-22:

1. **93.98%** of the students responded positively about more than 80 percent of the syllabus was covered during the session in due course of time. 32 students responded that less than 50% of the syllabus was covered during the session. The college arranged remedial/extra classes.
2. **82.51%** of the students responded that the teachers were delivering the lectures after due preparation of the content before starting the class. 17.48% of students were of the opinion that sometimes the teachers were not prepare effectively for the class lectures.
3. Out of **532** respondents **499** were of the opinion that teacher's communication was very effective during class lectures. And 33 respondents were of the opinion that there is a room for development in the communication skill of the teachers.
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as excellent by 239 students, very good by 196 students, good by 79 students, fair by 11 students and poor only by 7students in context of teachers approach towards to teaching.
5. **82.51%** of the students responded that there is a fair process of internal evaluation in the college for the students in different subjects. And 17.48 % were of the opinion that internal evaluation system needs to improve.
6. Out of **532** respondents **477** were of the opinion that teacher's share and discuss the performance of students and highlight the lacunas left during the session in academics.
7. 455 students out of 532 were satisfied with **the institute for taking active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students through various curricular, co-curricular, subject tours and field visits.**
8. **The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth students in which 238 students** responded very well, 166 responded satisfactorily, 92 responded moderately, 22 responded marginally and only 14 students did not cooperate the opinion.
9. Large number of students was of the opinion that college provides ample opportunities to learn and grow.
10. Maximum number of students was of the opinion that teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

11. Maximum number of students were of the opinion that mentor follow up is regular for the development of the comprehension of the given the given task.
12. Most of the students expressed that the teachers identify their strengths and encourage/inculcate with providing right level of challenges.
13. There is a mentor-mentee system in the college which enables to recognize the weakness of the students and provide road map to overcome these weaknesses.
14. Large number of students responded that teacher uses problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences. Institute teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning and participative for improving learning experiences of students.
15. The student community is quite satisfied with the efforts made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work.
16. Most of the students expressed teachers use ICT tools and e-resources such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. in teaching. 80.07% of the student expressed that most of the teachers uses ICT tools in teaching and learning. It also shows augmentation of technology and learning in the college.
17. The suggestion put forth by the student community for overall teaching and learning experience / development is as under:
 - A. 236 students suggested that there should be more smart classrooms in the college campus.
 - B. 212 students suggested that there should be a proper availability of ICT tools in the institution.
 - C. 84 students demanded that more reading rooms should be made available for the students.

Action Taken:

1. The college administration has initiated various steps to make Library of the college more advanced and provide digital resources like: N-List programme through library to enhance the academic and research facilities in the institution.
2. The college administration started working on the issues raised by the students on ICT tools and E- resources such as LCD projector, multimedia and smart class rooms shall be build in the college classes.
3. College starts to make more participation of the students in various administrative reforms of the college to make teaching and learning process more efficient.
4. In the college the traditional classrooms were shifted to smart class room by installing smart boards in every class room.
5. To enhance the teaching abilities of the teachers the college provided ample opportunities for them to attend FDP/ Orientation Programmes.
6. To recognize and inculcate the talent of the students a number of program (Seminar/Conference and Workshop) being organized.
